Our Friday night dinners will start up in January. A sign-up sheet will be posted in the Lounge for anyone interested in preparing a dinner.

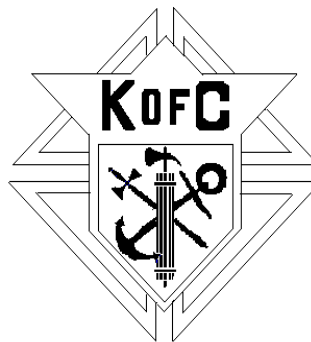
Please remember to donate to the food basket in the Knights Lounge for the Holy Trinity pantry.

Financial Secretary's Report

The Charter Constitution Law State: Members who have attained the actual age of sixty-five years and who have been members of the order twenty five consecutive years, shall be designated as Honorary Members and on due request in writing to the Council will be awarded the designation.

Members who have attained the actual age of seventy years and who have been members of the Order for twenty five consecutive years and those who have been members of the Order for fifty consecutive years of age shall be designated as Honorary Members and on due request in writing shall receive the Honors.

Please note that in both Honorary and Honorary Life, the council must receive a request in writing from the member requesting to become Honorary or Honorary Life Members.
