Our prayers go out to Brothers John McMillan and Barry Clark who lost their mothers this past month.

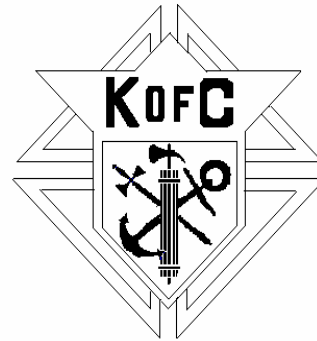
Please remember to donate to the food basket in the Knights Lounge for the Holy Trinity pantry.
