On Wednesday, February 20th we have a Second Degree at Council 367. This would be a good time for all First Degree Brothers to get their Second Degree.

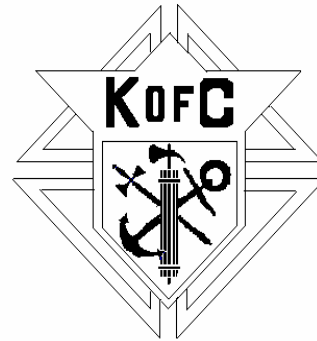
The 2008 bingo schedule is posted in this newsletter, and a big thanks to all those who help with bingo.
