HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY

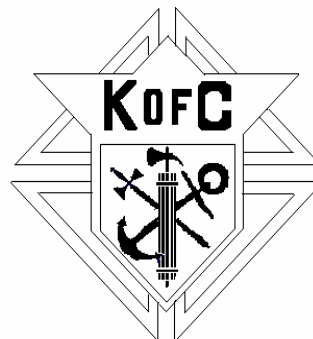
It's that time of year again, the parade will be upon us in no time .Only a few more weeks.
