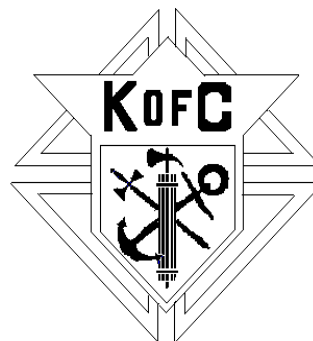
From The Grand Knights Desk,

## Field Agent Report
