## From The Grand Knights Desk,

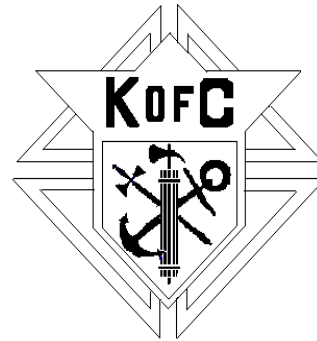
Dear Brother Knights and Family

## Insurance
