I want to especially thank Brother Knight John McMillan for his work on our newsletter.

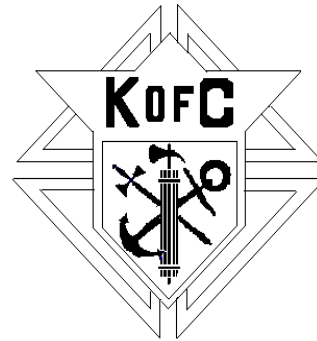
And last, but not least, I would like to thank our bingo staff for all their many hours of hard work to make our bingo a success.
