With Summer fast approaching as you travel remember to use your seat belts and drive safe.

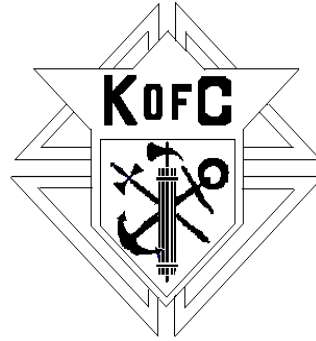

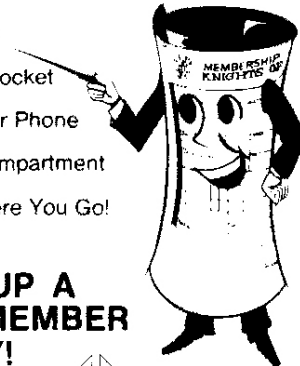
