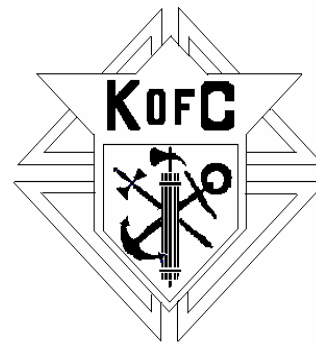
From The Grand Knights Desk,
