I would like to thank the parade committee for all the hard work and planning for the parade. I thank everyone who came out and volunteered to work the parade.

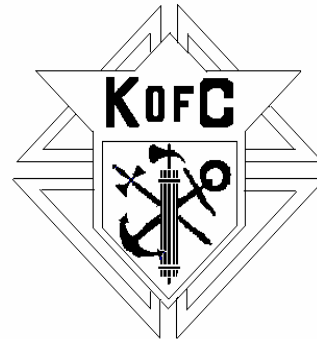
