Dear Brother Knights and Family,

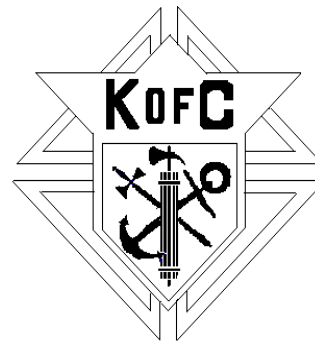
