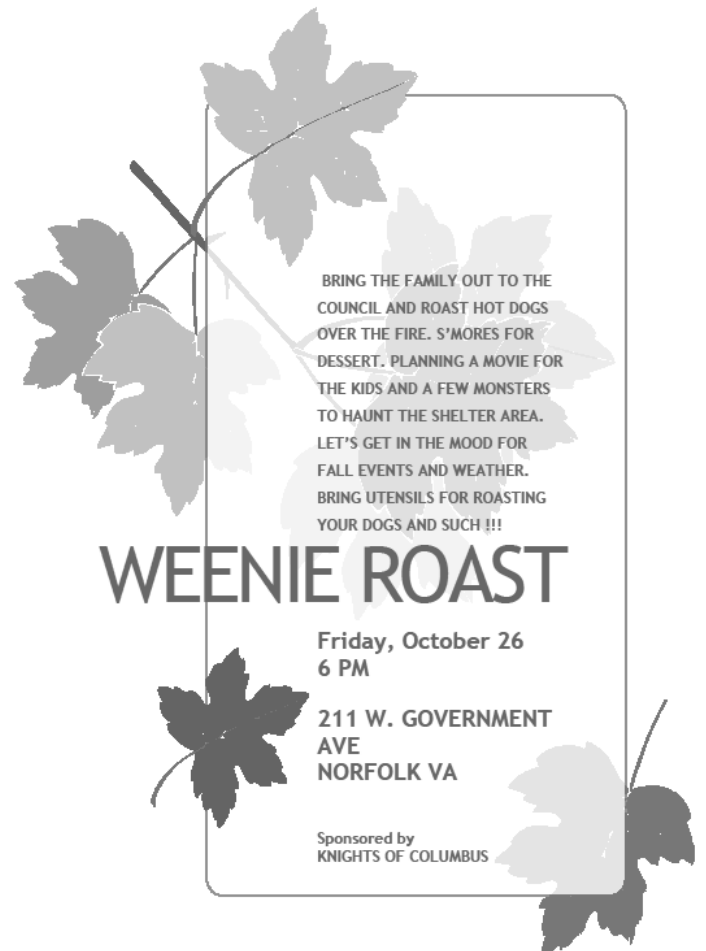
Membership Information
