A CALL TO HISTORY-PART 3, THE COUNCIL HOME & COLUMBIAN CLUB

The activities, projects, and moral codes which we establish in our time serve as a cherished legacy to perpetually guide other Brother Knights in turn. All of the traditions, all of the workings of our council, all of the internationally famous projects of the Order have been originated, developed and executed by individual knights.

The Knights of the Past have bequeathed to us, as their successors, the responsibility of continuing and improving upon the great work they toiled so long and so hard to firmly establish.

During the summer of 1952, the new members worked diligently to accomplish the impossible: transform their dream into reality, a permanent home for Father Robert B. Kealey Council members. This was not an easy task. There were many difficult and insurmountable obstacles. But strong determination, unity and faith made it possible for us to enjoy today the fine facilities of our new and permanent home.

It must be understood that the Supreme Council would not permit a subordinate council to acquire property in the name of the Knights of Columbus because of potential legal entanglements associated with such a venture. It is for this very reason that a small group of charter members of the Father Kealey Council, in conjunction with their first Grand Knight F. A. Lambden, formed and incorporated the Columbian Club.

Plans were formulated for the construction of a building which would satisfy the demands of Father Kealey Council and the Columbian Club. The temporary facilities from the year 1952 to 1961 were quite inadequate for social functions, degrees, banquets, and even normal business meetings.

How did it all get started?... Much credit must be given to those few, particularly Brother Frederick T. Stant, Jr., Father Kealey Council legal counselor, and Past Grand Knight Ernest A. Morgan, who together championed the idea of expansion of our council and had the foresight to bring all the legal aspects of land purchase and construction of our new home to a successful settlement. One of the many facets of this complex operation will be discussed in the next issue.
